PARENT INFORMATION – JANUARY 2018

It is hard to believe that the Christmas holidays are long gone, already we can see a slight 'stretch' to the day! At the start of this New Year, and a new term, we thought we would give you an update on forthcoming events, as we anticipate a busy time ahead.

MORNING ROUTINE!

Please remember that school cannot provide supervision or take responsibility for pupils who are dropped off before 8.30am. We would request that you do not leave your children unattended at school before this time, as we believe it is unsafe to do so.



We thank you once again for your co-operation in not using the turning circle as a parking space. Parents should only stop in the turning circle long enough to allow children to get out of the car and not leave the car parked in this area whilst walking their child into school. We would ask that, for health and safety reasons, children are only permitted to get out of cars on the <u>pedestrian side</u> of the turning circle and should be prevented from exiting into the path of on-coming vehicles.

We would also like to emphasise that parents are asked not to accompany their child into the school building in the morning but should leave them at the appropriate gate. If your child is late to school, they should be brought to the school office.

PARKING IN AND AROUND SCHOOL



Sadly, we have once again been receiving phone calls concerning cars obstructing footpaths and blocking driveways whilst children are being left off/collected from school. Please be mindful of the safety of pedestrians/other road users and considerate of those who live in the area, when parking both inside and outside school grounds.

Parents are asked to be vigilant at all times when driving into/out of school grounds and also, when on foot, to watch carefully to ensure children do not cross in front of moving vehicles. Adults and children alike should always use the designated crossing areas. Please emphasise to your child that they are to wait at the relevant school gate each morning – under no circumstances are they to play or run about in the car parks or on the turning circle.

In order to reduce risks to safety, when entering the school gates, please do not turn right to enter the visitors' car park but rather follow the one-way system around the turning circle.

MINIVERSITY

MINIVERSITY is an after-school club for children interested in learning about computers. Each session touches on a 'careers' themed topic. The children are given ICT tasks using a variety of different programmes covering various careers, such as 'Drone Programmer', 'Interpreter' or 'Pilot'. The senior club is currently fully subscribed, however, there are still places available in the junior club for P1 to P3, which runs each Thursday from 2.00 pm to 3.00 pm.


SCHOOL DINNERS


PRAISE AND PRAYER NIGHT
