Dear parents/guardians,

May I begin this letter by thanking you for your many kind words of congratulations, support and encouragement as I take up the post of Principal of Dromore Central PS. I look forward to continuing to work closely with you, and to seek new ways of building up our school community together.

May I also take this opportunity to thank you for your generosity in contributing to Mrs Allen's retirement. The special assembly showcased the pupils' many talents and your help in preparation for this event is much appreciated by the staff – the children were fantastic, fulfilling every task with a sense of joy, humour and dedication to DCPS. Moving forward, October will be another busy month as we host several key school events.

### **Harvest Celebrations:**

Our Harvest assemblies will be held on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Our normal practice is to aid the local foodbank at Via Wings by collecting non-perishable food items. If you would like to donate tins of food, biscuits etc. please send these items into school by Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October.

### **Cash for Clobber:**

Our next Cash for Clobber collection will take place on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Please note that pillows and duvets cannot be reused for hygiene reasons. All money raised will go towards the purchasing of ICT equipment in school.

### **Parent-Teacher Consultations:**

Many of you have expressed a desire to see these return to face-to-face meetings with teachers, however I am also conscious that a 3-year contract has been purchased for online meetings via School Cloud. In preparation for this, Mrs Murray will spend one day meeting the pupils and staff in school. I apologise for any inconvenience this may cause, but feel it is essential for Mrs Murray to spend some time with her teaching colleagues before having to "hit the ground running" on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup>. ### **SENCo:**

As many of you will already be aware, Mrs Mackay changed her name over the summer and is now officially known as Ms Leonard. I know this will take some of us a period to adjust, so she assures me she will continue to respond to both names for the foreseeable future!

### **School Fund:**

At the last Board of Governors' meeting in June, the resourcing for ICT was discussed. As we all know, ICT is an ever-changing area and money is continuously needed to replace broken items and purchase new apps/equipment etc. The aim would be to eventually have 1 iPad per 2 children. Currently, we have 8 iPads per classroom, thus needing to increase this to 15 per classroom, meaning we would like to purchase an additional 176 iPads.

To assist with raising these funds, we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £20.00 per child (eldest child only; £10.00 per each additional sibling thereafter) which can be paid using the School Money app. This would give us more than £10 000 to further progress the work of ICT in school. Many thanks for giving this some consideration.
